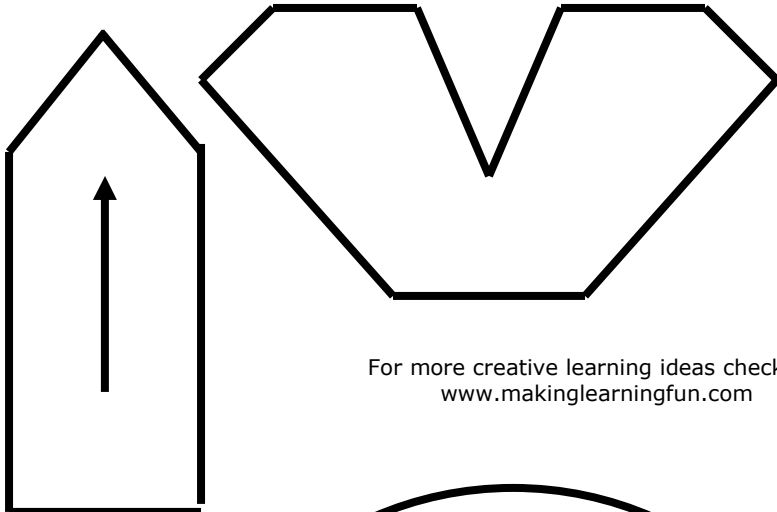


Cardboard Turkey Craft

Cut the pieces below out of cardboard. It works best if you can find a piece with no writing. Look at the cardboard. Inside, between the top and back layers are little tunnels. Make sure that the inside tunnels in the cardboard run the direction of the arrows. Cut five feathers. Have the kids paint the pieces, and let them dry. Cut five two inch pieces of pipe cleaner. Run a pipe cleaner into the feathers and stick the other end into the turkey circle. Glue the head piece onto the body leaving about 1/8 " of space. Glue the feet on butting them up into the 1/8" space. I used felt for the beak and hole punches of black fun foam for eyes. This will stand up on it's own if glued together properly. If you have the children paint the feathers like the picture shown, take a minute to talk about symmetry.
